



WORK 08 UPDATE

After a cold winter, we're in a wet spring! But we have been getting work done in between the showers. Harris Overpass in Lincoln is on track to hit its two completion dates. Marty, Josh, Jake, Jeff, Nels, Bob, Chuck and newly promoted, Ryan Graham, are all out there working on the 1900' viaduct. Half of it has to be done by June 6th and the rest by November 12th. It has incentives/disincentives of \$3500/day and \$11,000/day respectively, so we're keeping the push on to the end.



In Council Bluffs, Mark has Scott D and Scott C getting ready to switch traffic this weekend so they can start removal on the 24th Street bridge. Evan is driving sheeting and installing a MSE wall at the I-80 Missouri River Bridge.

Larry is ready to pour deck in Mahaska county. He's been waiting for a few weeks on weather. Dave has poured one overlay in Keokuk county and has two more to go. Jack finished a steel beam repair in Dubuque and is heading to Sioux City. There, Kelly and Ben have already opened up a stage of the 4000' viaduct to overlay.

The other large overlay we have, Ottumwa, is well under way where Tim, Doug and Brad should be making their first pour this week.

Lastly, Chad is finishing the concrete work on the Center Street Arched Ped Bridge and will begin installing falsework for the steel arch and decks.
